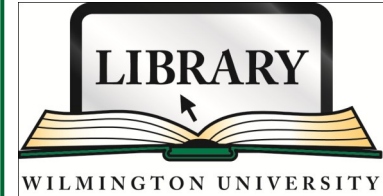
Delaware Library Catalog
