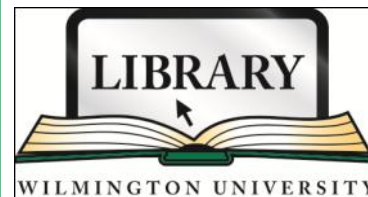

Electronic Databases Guide

Wilmington University Library offers access to a variety of electronic resources available for research in a variety of subject areas. The number of databases is ever-expanding to fit the needs of all users. From off campus simply visit the Library homepage and click on 'Electronic Databases' beneath the 'Research' category. Once a database is chosen from the list, you will be prompted to login to your Blackboard account. This will allow access to all of the Library's databases.

Available Electronic Resources

Access Science

Gathers and synthesizes vast amounts of information, and organizes it to give you fast, easy and accurate access to authoritative articles in all major areas of science and technology.

AgeLine (EBSCOhost)

Abstracts the literature of social gerontology as well as aging-related research from psychology, sociology, social work, economics, public policy, and the health sciences.

American History in Video

This streaming video series is the only source for complete online newsreel streams of United News and Universal Newsreel; important documentaries and series from The History Channel and others.

Annual Reviews

A full-text database covering the fields of law, social sciences, psychology and sociology.

Books In Print

Describes over 4 million records for in-print, out-of-print, and forthcoming books, audios, and videos.

Choice Reviews Online

This database contains reviews of academic books, websites, and other resources, along with info about the user level.

CQ Researcher Online

Full-text, in-depth coverage of political and social issues, including topics in health, international affairs, education, the environment, technology, and economy.

Credo Reference

Credo Reference offers online access to more than 500 highly-regarded titles including dictionaries, subject encyclopedias, handbooks, gazetteers, atlases & directories from over 70 publishers and covers every major subject.

Criminal Justice Periodical Index

Provides abstracts and full text articles from various periodicals related to criminal justice topics.

Dissertations and Theses

Contains bibliographic citations and abstracts online for doctoral dissertations as well as some master's theses completed at accredited North American colleges and universities.

Education Full-Text Journal Collection from Taylor & Francis

Search the contents of full-text education journals.

Encyclopedia Britannica Online

Includes the complete encyclopedia, Internet guide to Web Sites, and *Merriam-Webster's Collegiate Dictionary*.

Gale Encyclopedia of American Law

A reference e-book which covers today's leading cases, major statutes, legal terms and concepts, notable persons involved with the law, and important documents.

Gale Virtual Reference Library

A reference e-book collection including Academic Law Yearbook, College Blue Book, and the Acronyms, Initialisms, Abbreviations Dictionary.

Google Scholar

Google Scholar provides a simple way to broadly search for scholarly literature.

Mergent Online

A source for finding fifteen years' worth of company financial information, personnel information, assets, SEC filings, and histories for more than 10,000 publicly owned companies.

National Newspapers

Provides full text for New York Times (1980-), Wall Street Journal (1984-), Washington Post (1987-), Los Angeles Times (1985-), and Christian Science Monitor (1988-).

NetLibrary eBook Collection

NetLibrary is a collection of over 5,000 e-books from many different subject areas.

The New England Journal of Medicine

The New England Journal of Medicine has published original medical research, case studies, and review articles since 1812. Full-text access online is available 1993-present.

Nursing E-Books from Rittenhouse

The R2 Digital Library provides full-text nursing e-books covering the areas of medicine and nursing.

Nursing Reference Center (NRC) (EBSCOhost)

Provides a user-friendly point-of-care resource intended for staff nurses, nurse administrators, nursing students, nurse faculty, and hospital librarians.

Opposing Viewpoints Resource Center

An online library of current event topics: the facts as well as the arguments of each topic's proponents and detractors.

Ovid Nursing Full-Text PLUS

A comprehensive single source of premier current journal content from Lippincott Williams & Wilkins. Access includes 33 research and 12 practitioner-oriented journals. Journal coverage dates as far back as 1995.

Sage Journals Online

Access to approximately 460 Peer-Reviewed Full-Text Journals covering the disciplines of Business, Humanities, Social Sciences, Science, Technology, and Medicine.

Sage Reference Online Methods & Evaluation

Search the contents of Encyclopedia of Measurement and Statistics and Encyclopedia of Survey Research Methods.

SBRnet (Sports Business Research Network)

Focuses on market research, industry news and archives, and links to web sites covering all aspects of the sports business.

Security Management Practices

An intelligence resource for Security Executives critical IT, legal, financial, and physical/enterprise security information.

The New Palgrave Dictionary of Economics

The online edition of The New Palgrave Dictionary of Economics contains the full text of the 8-volume print edition.

The Statesman's Yearbook
