

Material Access

- ◆ **ID/Library Card**– Library materials can be borrowed by using your Student ID. ID cards can be obtained at each site. Those unable to obtain an ID card may request materials by using your student ID number which is noted on your enrollment form.
- ◆ **Material Delivery**– Students enrolled at sites other than in New Castle can have materials mailed to their home by calling the 800 Line. Materials requested by faculty and staff are sent to their site mail box.
- ◆ **Interlibrary Loan**- Materials not owned by Wilmington University, DTCC Libraries or unavailable electronically can be obtained through Interlibrary Loan. Requests can be made online or by calling the 800 Line. Web delivery is an option for some materials.

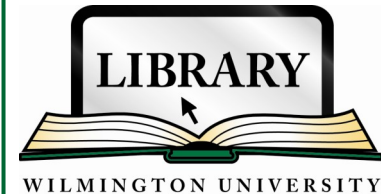
