## Delaware Library Catalog

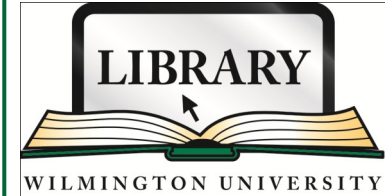
