

## Material access for sites other than Main Campus

- ◆ **Material Delivery**– Students enrolled at sites other than in New Castle can have materials mailed to their home by calling the 800 Line. Materials requested by faculty and staff are sent to their site mail box.
- ◆ **ID/Library Card**– Library materials can be borrowed by using your Student ID with a barcode. ID cards can be obtained at each site. Those unable to obtain an ID card may request a “Library Borrower Card” by completing the form @ <http://www.wilmu.edu/library/borrowingcard.pdf>
- ◆ **Interlibrary Loan**- Materials not owned by Wilmington University, DTCC Libraries or unavailable electronically can be obtained through Interlibrary Loan. Requests can be made online or by calling the 800 Line. Web delivery is an option for articles.

## What Is WebCat?

- ◆ WebCat is the online catalog of the Wilmington University Library.
- ◆ Using WebCat you can access the record of any item the Wilmington University Library owns.
- ◆ Citations for books, videos, DVDs, periodical titles, e-books, and reserve readings can all be found using WebCat.
