COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course will help students further develop their composition skills and become proficient in college-level research writing. Students will continue to use the writing strategies they learned in ENG 121 and apply to them to four essays, including an 8-10 page researched, argumentative paper. Students will develop information literacy skills, including how to search for, evaluate, and utilize scholarly sources. Students will further develop their knowledge of APA formatting and apply it to each writing assignment. Students will learn about academic integrity and submit each essay draft through Turnitin.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

This course will provide students with the knowledge and skills to:

1. Develop persuasive writing strategies to address a specific purpose.
2. Compose argument essays for a specific audience.
3. Examine example texts and other media.
4. Demonstrate effective research strategies
5. Analyze sources
6. Integrate sources
7. Assess one's own writing and the writing of peers
8. Edit writing for mechanics, grammar, usage, organization, unity, coherence, conciseness, and clarity.
9. Demonstrate correct APA paper formatting and citation.
