Contact Andrea Camoirano in Student Financial Services: (302) 356-6948.</li> <li>Family members using transferred benefits <ul> <li>Complete VA Form 22-1990e (Application for Family Members to Use Transferred Benefits) to apply for Transfer of Entitlement (TOE).</li> <li>Complete and submit to the VA once the Department of Defense has approved the request.</li> <li>Do not use Form 22-1990e to apply for transfer of education benefits.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
	STEP 3:	<ul> <li>Contact all of your previously attended institutions to have your official transcripts sent to us. • wilmu.edu/ElectronicTranscripts</li> <li>Official transcripts include but are not limited to: previously attended colleges, CLEP/DSST exams, military training, Joint Services Transcript (request at JST.doded.mil/official.html) and Community College of the Air Force (request at AirUniversity.af.edu/Barnes/CCAF).</li> </ul>

Students may need to submit test scores and/or additonal documentation in order to be admitted into select programs. Please visit wilmu.edu/Academics to find your program and its admission requirements.
