Graduate Certificate

The **Administration in Higher Education** certificate is designed for those interested in transitioning to or advancing their careers in higher education administration. This certificate focuses on law, budgeting, human resource management and data-driven decision making. Students will participate in 120 hours of field-based work to gain experience in a higher education setting. Students will also complete a portfolio to highlight their work.
