Graduate Certificate

The graduate certificate in English Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) Literacy is for educators interested in teaching students who are not native English speakers. It offers teachers an opportunity to increase expertise in literacy instruction relative to the needs of ESOL students. Course content is focused at the classroom level to enable teachers to meet the diverse literacy needs of K-12 children.

This certificate includes coursework required by the Delaware Department of Education and is built around the TESOL standards. Candidates must be working in an educational setting to complete coursework.
