The **Student Affairs in Higher Education** certificate is designed for those interested in transitioning to or advancing their careers in student affairs. This certificate focuses on student development, assessing student learning, legal issues and an overview of service areas within student affairs. Students will participate in 120 hours of field-based work to gain experience in a higher education setting. Students will also complete a portfolio to highlight their work.
