Undergraduate Certificate

This certificate will benefit those seeking increased knowledge in the needs of the Hispanic population — needs that cannot be addressed adequately due to language and cultural barriers. These barriers can impede access to health care, thereby increasing the risk for health-related problems to occur. The certificate offers areas of study that include cultural beliefs, customs and the associated barriers that can lead to inadequate health care.

Multiple career opportunities exist for those individuals with knowledge of the Hispanic culture and a degree of fluency in the Spanish language. This added knowledge is desirable in numerous health care employment settings.


