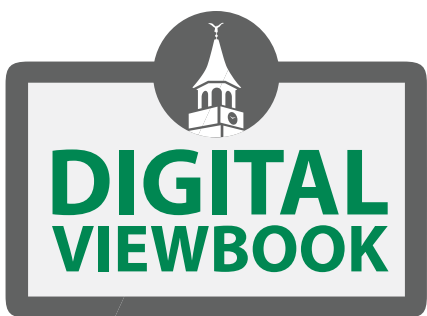

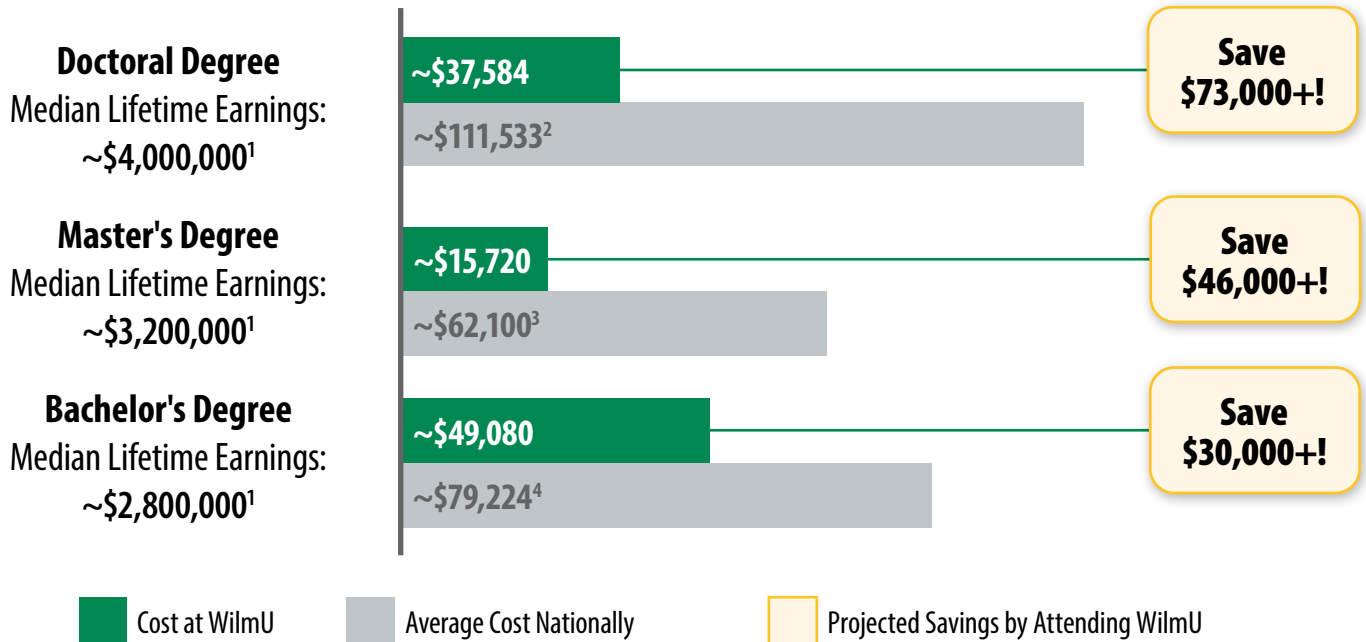

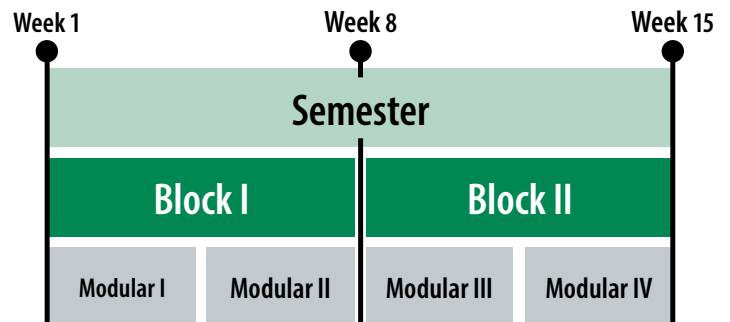

Course Scheduling Options

WilmU offers several course scheduling options, which allow students to schedule their courses in ways that best fit their lives and learning styles. The graphic below illustrates the three possible course scheduling options.



- Semester** The course will take place over 15 weeks.
- Block** The course will take place over 7 weeks. Two blocks (Block I and Block II).
- Modular** The course will take place over 2 weeks, and will only be held on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays.

Financial Aid 101

Any kind of funding to help pay for college is considered financial aid. It includes:

Scholarships

Many organizations provide scholarships to students. WilmU also awards a number of scholarships each year to our students based on various criteria.

Employer Reimbursement

Many businesses help their employees pay for school. Contact your employer's human resources department to see if tuition benefits are available.

Military Benefits

Individuals who have served or are currently serving in the military — as well as their dependents — may be eligible to have their tuition covered under veterans' benefits.

Federal Student Aid

Federal Student Aid is the most common form of financing for students. To be considered for federal aid, you must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

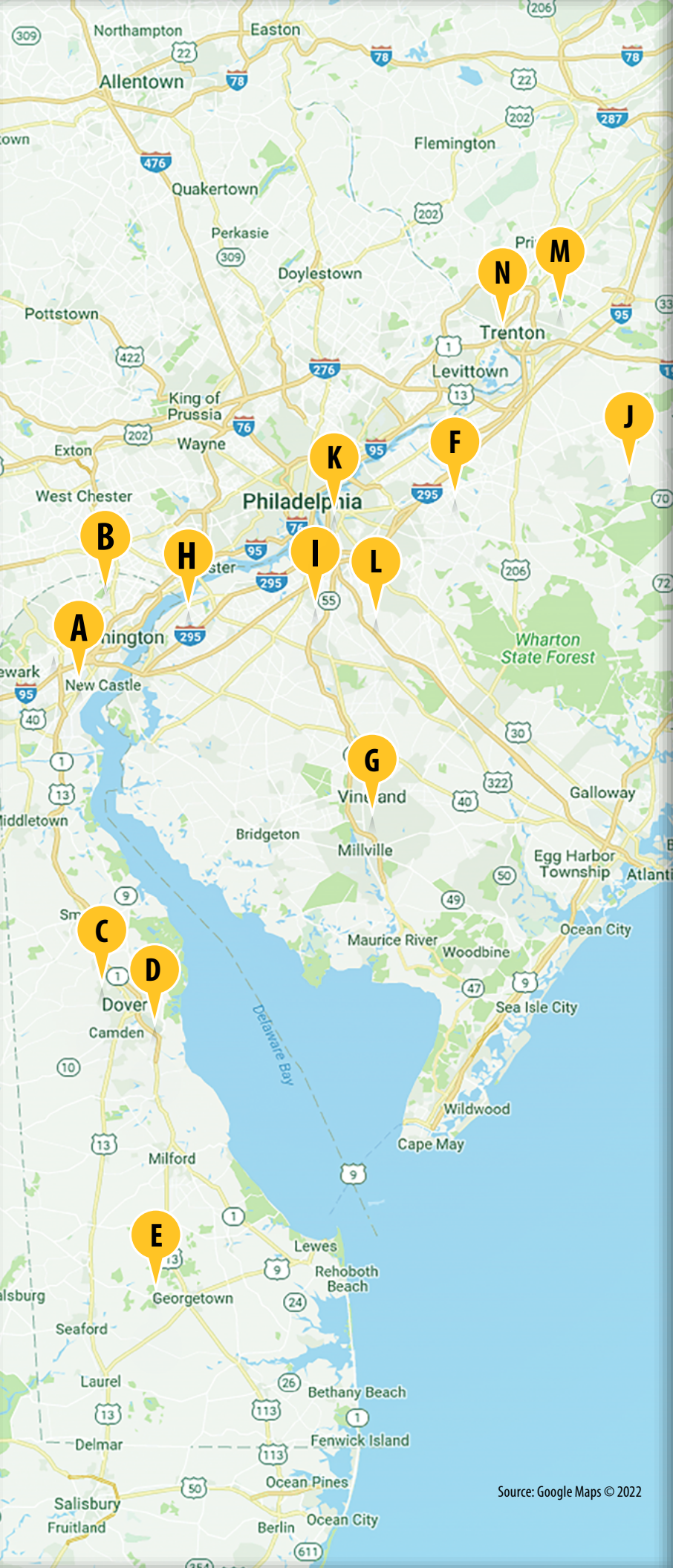
