Wilmington University's Post-Bachelor's Paralegal certificate prepares you with the professional and academic skills to work as a paralegal, providing indispensable support to legal teams in the public and private sectors of the law. This certificate program is designed to provide the education needed to begin a paralegal career, working under the supervision of an attorney, or advance an existing career in related fields. Because certificate programs are highly valued by those in the legal field, it is perfect for those who want to enhance marketability, make a career change, or expand career options.

Each course within the program has been strategically selected and designed by experienced paralegals and attorneys to deliver the knowledge, skills, and values necessary to enter the legal field upon graduation and perform the critical job functions of a competent and ethical professional working in the legal services industry.

The curriculum consists of eight classes (24 credits), and can be tailored to the individual student through the selection of two substantive electives. Students who are actively pursuing a bachelor's degree at Wilmington University will be permitted to enroll in this post-bachelor's certificate program, but will not receive a certificate until conferral of their bachelor's degree.

Face-to-Face/Synchronous Requirement

Students must take a minimum of 9 credits of legal specialty courses through traditional, face-to-face or synchronous classroom instruction. This requirement may be satisfied through any combination of semester, block or hybrid courses.


Legal Studies Program Competencies
