

Family Nurse Practitioner

Post-Graduate Certificate

This program provides a pathway for master's-prepared nurses to acquire the requisite training to become a nurse practitioner. The curriculum emphasizes relationships among advanced nursing practice, theory and scholarly inquiry through didactic coursework and 700 hours of clinical practicum completed within various clinical settings. Graduates are eligible for National Board certification as a Family Nurse Practitioner through the American Nurses Credentialing Center or the American Academy of Nurse Practitioners Certification Board.

Core Courses (16 Credits)

Each student will undergo a GAP analysis to confirm the completion of Advanced Practice Roles, Advanced Pathophysiology, Advanced Pharmacology and Advanced Health Assessment across the lifespan. If any of these courses have not been completed, then students must complete them during the program.
