

Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioner

Post-Graduate Certificate

This program is designed for nurses who hold a master's degree in nursing. It requires 27 credits of coursework, and students are required to maintain a GPA of 3.0 or above.

The **Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioner (PMHNP) Graduate Certificate** track prepares graduates to provide comprehensive mental health services to diverse populations in various clinical settings. The program combines theory, practice and therapeutic interventions to promote the highest level of care in the mental health community. The program includes 700 practicum hours. Graduates will meet the requirements of the American Nurses Credentialing Center (ANCC) and will be eligible to take the PMHNP certification examination or the American Academy of Nurse Practitioners exam (AANP).

Core Courses (12 Credits)

Completion of Advanced Practice Roles, Advanced Pathophysiology, Advanced Pharmacology and Advanced Health Assessment across the lifespan at the APRN level is a prerequisite for enrollment in the program. Students who have not completed these courses must do so prior to enrollment.
