

Post-MSN Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioner Graduate Certificate

Wilmington University's **Post-MSN Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioner** certificate program has been developed for nurses who have a master's degree and are nationally certified, licensed, family nurse practitioners. This program can be completed in as little as 15 months. Coursework consists of 24 credits, and students must maintain a grade point average of 3.0 or above.

The Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioner (PMHNP) post-graduate certificate track prepares graduates to provide comprehensive mental health services to diverse populations in the primary care setting. The certificate program combines theory, practice and therapeutic interventions to promote the highest level of care in the mental health community. The program includes 500 practicum hours in a variety of clinical settings. Graduates of the PMHNP track will meet the requirements of the American Nurses Credentialing Center (ANCC) and will be eligible to take the PMHNP certification examination.
