


## DW *What-If* How To Guide

### How To Load Your DegreeWorks Audit From Your myWilmU Account

Once logged into your myWilmU account:



1. Click the Registration and Records Icon
2. On the left-hand side, under "Before Registration" click



3. This will load your Degree Works which is an audit of courses you have transferred and/or courses you have taken with WilmU. On here you can view your major, your student ID number, GPA, which courses you have remaining, grades of previously taken courses and any certificate programs you are enrolled in.

- **To view your Certificate Degree Works Audit**
  - Click the drop down arrow for "Degree" next to your Name
