Here's how to get started:



STEP 1: Apply for admission to the Margaret H. Rollins School of Nursing at Beebe Healthcare.

STEP 1: Apply for Wilmington University (WilmU) admission at wilmu.edu/Apply.



STEP 2: Meet with a WilmU Partnership Specialist to learn about the coursework necessary for admission into the Margaret H. Rollins School of Nursing at Beebe Healthcare.



STEP 3: Complete your necessary coursework and earn up to 30 academic credits.



STEP 4: Take the TEAS preadmission exam.



STEP 5: Earn your R.N. at the Margaret H. Rollins School of Nursing at Beebe Healthcare.

STEP 5: If your plans change, continue your education in WilmU's B.S. in Health Sciences.



STEP 6: Once you complete your R.N., continue into WilmU's R.N. to BSN pathway.
