


VMware Horizon Download and Installation for Windows

To access VMware Horizon please follow this link: apps.wilmu.edu

From there you will be greeted with the screen below. For best performance we recommend downloading the VMware Horizon Desktop Client:




*To Download the VMware Horizon Client click the blue link at the bottom

Next find the download for the operating system you are on (Windows, Mac, Chrome, etc) Click Go To Downloads to the right


Once the VMware Horizon Client has been downloaded it can be located in your Downloads folder in your web browser or through your File Explorer on your computer. Click the download to continue with the install.


Once the client has been successfully installed select Finish and you'll want to restart your computer so the configuration changes made to VMware Horizon Client can take effect.




After your computer has restarted the VMware Horizon Client should now be accessible on your computer. The icon will appear as it does below:




Click on the + Add Server option to the top-right



Then type in the server name apps.wilmu.edu and choose to Connect




You will be taken to the Wilmington University login page. Put in your full credentials as you would usually do when signing into your account:


The you'll see choose application and open link. Select the VMware Horizon Client has the application and link:





Connecting to the Remote Desktop Server using browser


Open your web browser and go to apps.wilmu.edu. Once there you will be greeted by this screen:




Click on “VMware Horizon HTML Access” and you will be redirected to a WilmU sign in page where you will need to enter your full email and password.



Once logged in, you will be presented with the screen below. Click on “Remote Desktop” to be automatically signed into the server.




There are 2 environments currently available to all users. The Remote Desktop and Creative Desktop.



Remote Desktop: This environment can be used for access to University offered software and will be a Windows desktop.

Available Software:



- vCloud




Creative Desktop: This desktop is used to access creative tools and is a Windows desktop.

Available Software:


